



HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR TREE



Cut half an inch to one inch off the bottom of the tree and immediately place it in a bucket of water overnight to ensure proper water absorption.

Cutting at an angle, creating a V-shape, or drilling a hole does not improve absorption and may make it more difficult to secure the tree safely in the stand.

The tree will absorb water rapidly, potentially a gallon on the first day, so do not let the water level drop below the base. Be sure to add water every day – water is essential to prevent the tree from drying out and becoming more flammable. (Keep the tree away from open flames.)

Only remove bark from the tree if absolutely necessary, as the outer layer absorbs the most water.

Before decorating, allow the tree to sit for about an hour to "settle" into its shape. It's recommended that one person hold the tree steady while another ensures it is straight and secures it in the stand.

Your tree may shed some dry needles during the first day or so as you set it up and decorate it. Simply knock them off and sweep them up. If properly cared for, the tree should not shed any more needles after this.
